RECORD OF DECISION

Background

1. The Council received late further submissions from the following persons;
 - (a) Kathryn Snook in support of submission 2040
 - (b) Antonio and Kerrie Rodrigous in support of submission 2525
 - (c) D&S Grimshaw in opposition to submission 2480
 - (d) Kennedys Bush Road Neighbourhood Association ('KBRNA') in opposition to submission 2170.
2. Clause 3(1)(e) of Schedule 2 to the Canterbury Earthquake (Christchurch Replacement District Plan) Order 2014 authorises the Chairperson of the Hearings Panel to decide whether to accept any late submissions.


Decision and directions

3. Having considered the late further submissions I am satisfied that acceptance of the late further submissions would meet the statutory requirements set out in clause 5(2) of Schedule 3

of the Order in Council. Hearings have not yet commenced on Stage 2 matters. Pre-hearing meetings have now been scheduled by the Secretariat for 6, 7, 10 and 18 August 2015, the notices for pre-hearing meetings are available on the Panel's website. It is the responsibility of the late further submitters to identify the relevant pre-hearing meeting and attend or arrange representation, and to comply with any directions of the Panel.

4. Accordingly I direct:

- (a) The late further submissions from Kathryn Snook, Antonio and Kerrie Rodrigous, D&S Grimshaw and KBRNA are accepted
- (b) If the late further submitters have not already done so they must serve a copy of their late submission on the primary submitter.
- (c) The Council is to serve this decision on the late further submitters and relevant primary submitters.
