**MINUTE**  
**re joint memorandum on Topic 9.5 dated 11 May 2016**

[1] At the resumed hearing on Topic 9.5 (which took place on 9 and 10 May 2016), the Panel requested that the Council consult with other parties to that portion of Chapter 9 hearing and file a memorandum in response to various concerns. As a result of their discussions a memorandum was filed, proposing an agreed process to address the Panel's concerns, and seeking to prepare a further revised proposal.<sup>1</sup>


[2] I direct, in terms of paragraph 4 of the memorandum:

- (a) A revised proposal, including a draft s 32 report, is to be provided by **3 p.m., 20 May 2016** to parties who have advised they wish to attend a facilitated drafting session (Ngāi Tahu, the Crown, David Brailsford and Jan Cook, Federated Farmers, Hands off Hagley and Michael Bayley).

<sup>1</sup> Parties to the memorandum were the Council, Ngāi Tahu, the Crown, Federated Farmers, David Brailsford and Jan Cook. The memorandum records that Hands off Hagley was provided with a draft copy of the memorandum, and Mr Schulte (on behalf of Mr Bayley) was also communicated with.

- (b) A facilitated drafting session, to be attended by any party with an interest in this Chapter who wishes to be involved, will be held on **25 May 2016 from 10 a.m.**, at the Hearing Venue, 348 Manchester Street. The facilitated drafting session will be led by Mr Stephen Daysh.
- (c) The Council is to lodge a further revised proposal and s 32 report by **3 p.m., 3 June 2016.**
- (d) Submitters are to lodge closing legal submissions in relation to this matter by **3 p.m., 10 June 2016.**
- (e) The Council is to lodge closing legal submissions by **5 p.m., 17 June 2016.**
